The 2020 U.S. General Election is Tuesday, November 3,2020, and it is more important than ever to go to the polls and vote for union-minded candidates. The people we elect will make decisions affecting our businesses, economy, and our future. I strongly encourage you to vote and make a difference on that Tuesday. The following are the rules for Georgia and South Carolina.

## Georgia:

Deadline to register online to vote, registering by mail to vote (postmarked by), and register in person to vote is Monday, October 5, 2020. The deadline to request a ballot by mail is (received by) Friday, October 30, 2020. The early voting period runs from Monday, October 12, 2020 to Friday, October 30, 2020, but dates and hours may vary based on where you live.

## South Carolina:

Deadline to register online to vote is Sunday, October 4, 2020. Deadline for registering by mail to vote is (postmarked by) Monday, October 5, 2020. Deadline to register in person to vote is Friday, October 2, 2020. Finally, the deadline to request a ballot by mail is (received by) Friday, October 30. 2020.
